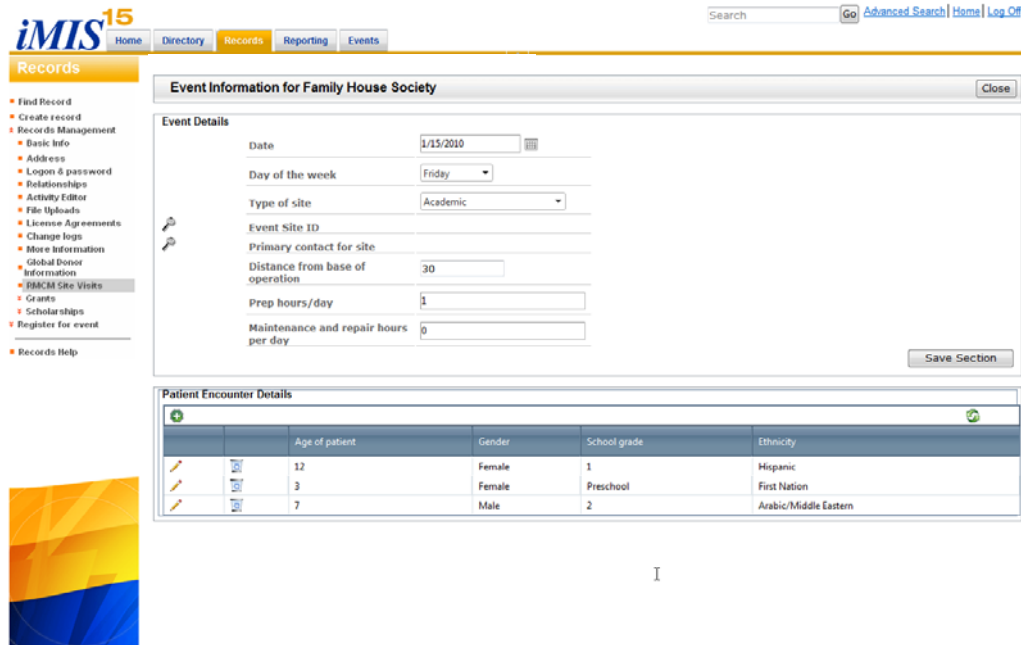

The **wvMulti-Instance** allows Web View users to create and edit any **iMIS** user defined multi-instance table. **wvMulti-Instance** consists of Simple and Expanded editors, providing the interface for a variety of multi-instance panel types from multiple tables on a single page. Creating and adding fields is easy and completed using standard **iMIS** tools.

### **wvMulti-Instance:**

- Uses standard **iMIS** multi-instance user defined tables
- Displays in **iMIS** using standard **iMIS** tools.
- Obeyes role-based security
- Provides view and edit security at the field level
- Allows fields from multiple tables to appear on the same page.
- Allows creation and edit of user defined field
- Allows long field prompts
- Allows tooltips for every field
- Allows fields to have an ID lookup using IQA queries.
- Allows for calculated, read-only fields.
- Allows descriptions before and after fields for better grouping of fields

**wvMulti-Instance** allows you to empower your users with the ability to use the browser based view of **iMIS** and still create and edit multi-instance table user defined fields as they would in **iMIS** desktop.

Other iParts currently in the **wvSuite** include: **wvActivity**, **wvRelationships**, and **wvFileUpload**.

**NOTE:** **wvMulti-Instance** requires **WCM**
